MEETING POINT > FORMULA 1 PADDOCKS

- For cars and vans, with a maximum height of 2m30, access to the paddock by the Ster Tunnel. Motorway Verviers - St. Vith (E42 - A27) • Exit n ° 10 : Francorchamps.
- For all other vehicles access by Blanchimont (4m height permitted). Motorway Verviers - St. Vith (E42 - A27) • Exit n ° 11 : Stavelot.

Please keep in mind the traffic circle to reach the F1 paddocks:

> In: through la Source Corner • Out: through the F1 ramp



The Welcome point will be in the Pit Brasserie, 2nd floor of the F1 pit-building, to do the administrative checking. You will get a written briefing as well as the details for your box and noise check procedure.

Payment of your registration: in cash or by credit card.

RESPECT OF NOISE LIMITS

On the track, the maximum sound level permitted is 103 dB, measured at 15m from the centreline of the track.

POLLUTION PREVENTION - STAINS ON THE FLOOR

The preparation (development and repairs) of the cars should be done in the box provided. If your car is parked in the paddocks, you must use a sheet of plastic or an oil drip tray under the racing car and trucks (carworkshop) to protect the ground against oil pollution.

For every remaining oil stain a penalty of €150 is invoiced by the circuit management to the team.

ACTIVITIES OF THE DAY AND INFORMATION TO ACCESS THE TRACK

9h00: Opening of the track

You can go out to the track as and when you like rather than in a dedicated time slot. There will be a race number provided by the organizer on the right front door of the car to allow access to the track.

- All road legal tyres are accepted. Vehicles should only run slick tyres if they are fitted with suitable roll-over protection.
- Convertible (cabriolet) must run with the hood closed and must be equipped with a roll-over bar for the driver and one for the passenger.
- Drivers take full responsibility for any casualties resulting from taking a passenger in their car. Only one (1) passenger is allowed per car. Passengers must be 18 years or over.
- When driving, drivers and passengers must wear crash helmets and fasten their safety belts at all times. The arms and legs of the occupants must be covered.
- Fuel is available at the petrol station located inside the paddocks down to the Eau Rouge. Only credit cards are accepted. Fuel is not included in the entry fee.
